Recognized organization – organization fulfilling the conditions prescribed by separate regulation and authorized by Ministry for performing statutory certification of maritime objects which includes inspection surveys and certification. Under provisions of Maritime Act and until the integration of the Republic of Croatia in to European union, **Croatian Register of Shipping** is recognized organization.

Recognized organization outside Croatia - organization fulfilling the conditions prescribed by IMO Resolutions A.739(18) and. A.789(19). For the purpose of the Regulation on statutory certification of boats and yachts recognized organizations are considered to be the following:

Under provisions of Maritime Act and until the integration of the Republic of Croatia in to European union, **Croatian Register of Shipping** is recognized organization.

Authorized body for issuance of Certificate of Compliance with the Directive 94/25/EC – organization fulfilling the conditions for issuance of Certificate of Compliance with the Directive 94/25/EC of the European Parliament and of the Council of 16 June 1994 on the approximation of the laws, regulations and administrative provisions of the Member States relating to recreational craft.
