## TOURISM, TRANSPORT AND DEVELOPMENT

Under Article 1021 Paragraph 5 and in relation to Article 188 Paragraph 4 and Article 203 Paragraph 4 of the Maritime Act (Official Gazette No. 181/04) Minister of Sea, Tourism, Transport and Development enacts the following:

## Decree

on the Compensation Fee for Entry of Ships, Yachts and Boats into Register of Ships, Register of Yachts or Register of Boats Respectively

Ι

By this Decree criteria and compensation fee (in further text: fee) for entry of ships, yachts and boats into register of ships, register of yachts or register of boats respectively are regulated.

ΙΙ

Fee specified in Article I of this Decree is paid on the occasion of the first entry of ship, yacht or boat into register of ships, register of yachts or register of boats respectively and in accordance to GT (Gross Tonnage) of the ship, length of the hull of yacht or length of the hull of boat.

Fee is defined in Tables 1, 2 and 3 in accordance to the criteria set in paragraph 1 of this Article and depending on the origin of the ship, yacht or boat:

III

Fee specified in Article I of this Decree is revenue of the State Budget of the Republic of Croatia and is paid on application for entry of ship, yacht or boat into the register of ships, register or yachts or register of boats.

IV

Compensation fee for entry of floating object and fixed offshore object into the register of floating objects and fixed offshore objects is regulated by the provisions of this Decree on fee for entry of ships in to registry of ships pursuant to Article 108 of the Maritime Act.

٧.

Compensation fee for the first entry of yachts and boats that had previously been register in the registry of inland waterway boats pursuant to the Regulation on inland waterway boats (Official Gazette no. 80/2000) into register of yachts and register of boats is payable in pursuant to Article II. of this Decree.

Ships, yachts and boats already registered in Croatian register of ships, register of yachts or register of boats are exempt from the payment of fee specified in Article I of this Decree when re-registering in other Croatian register.

Boats that prior to the entry into force of the Regulation on Boats and Yachts (Official Gazette no. 27/2005) were not subject to the entry in the register of boats are also exempt from the payment of fee specified in Article I of this Decree provided that the owner of the boat produces the bill of sale, customs declaration or other relevant evidence of ownership proving the boat had been obtained prior to the entry into force of the Regulation.

VII.

Decree on the Compensation Fee for Entry of Ships, Yachts and Boats into Register of Ships, Register of Yachts or Register of Boats Respectively (Official Gazette no. 2/2005) shall be abrogated with coming into force of this Decree.

This Decree shall come into force on the day of publishing in Official Gazette.
