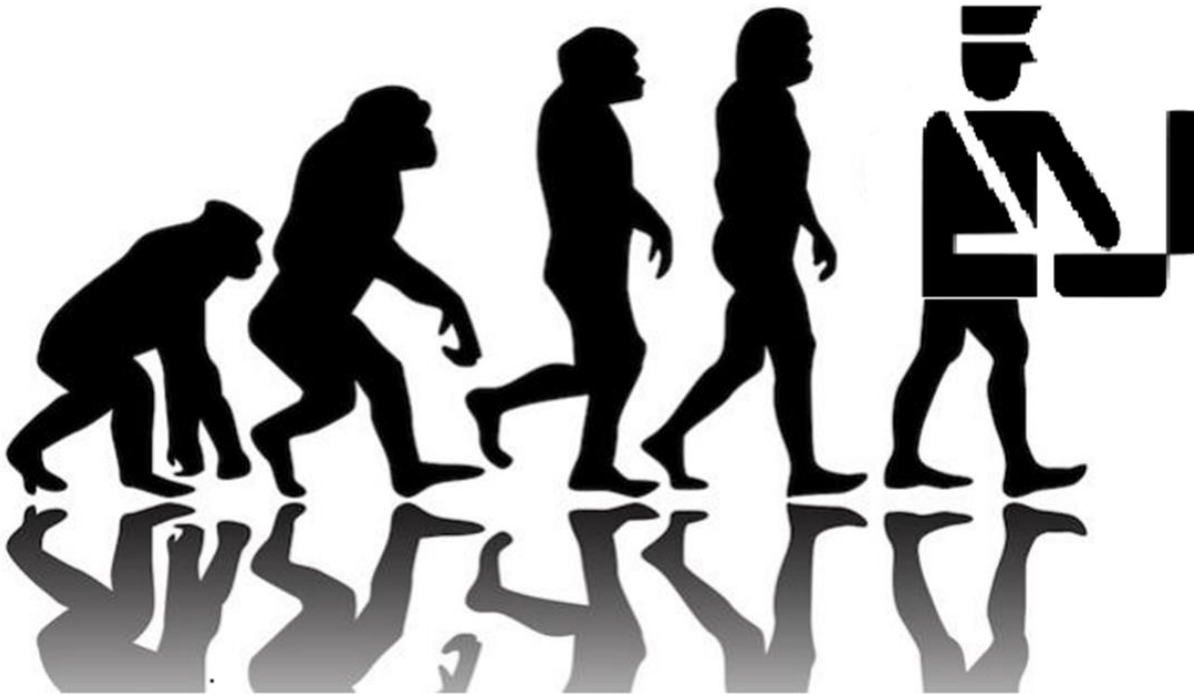
Logistics and Customs Clearance

Important goal →

- **Logistics industry = In-time delivery !**
 - **Customs = Supervision + control + duties**
- IT Solutions = SW + PCS**

- Reporting formalities directive – 2010/65
- Single market act II
- UCC →
 - Article 6
 - EU SW
- DG Move →
 - E-Manifest
 - MSW

Single Window

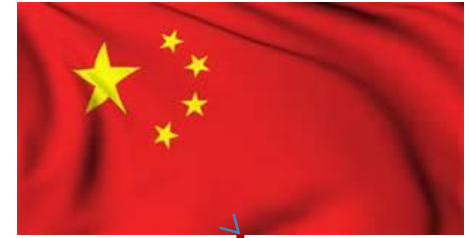
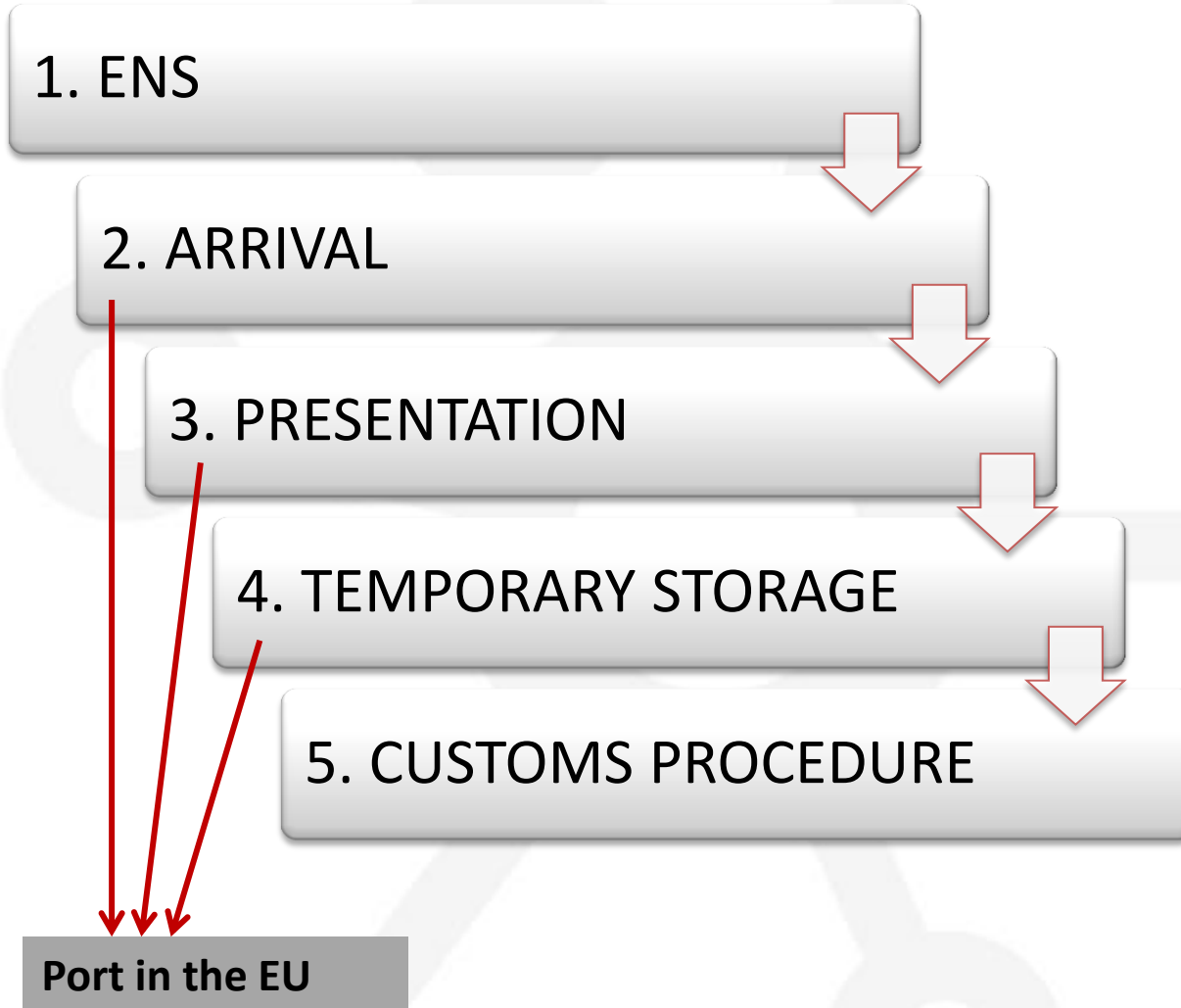
MSW → activities DG Move

- “New” Extension MSW / e-Manifest pilot
 - Arrival Notification
 - Notification about Presentation
 - Declaration for Temporary Storage
 - **Not included = ENS**

EU SW → activities DG TAXUD

- Partner in the e-Manifest project / supporting DG Move
- PG for an SW approach on Customs issues from Q 4 / 2016

Customs pentalogy



Single Window

MSW → current situation

- FAL 1 – vessel notification

- **FAL 2 – cargo manifest**

= Customs information

- FAL 3 – ship store

- FAL 4 – personal affairs

- FAL 5 – crew member list

- FAL 6 – passenger list

- FAL 7 – dangerous goods

EXCLUDED from MSW

Single Window + PCS

Problems / issues →

- Time factor / response times
- Process flow for message exchange
- Data content – mandatory information
- Validation scheme?
- Amendments / adjustments
- Responsibility / confidentiality → re-use of data
- Temporary Storage = today no harmonisation

→ Port Community System = interface solution ?!



Port Community Systems

Solution →

- **Manifest in ports =**
 - Private industry level: need for logistical flow !
 - Administration level: MSW + Customs
- **PCS receives this information for the private sector and prepare the necessary notifications / messages for all parties; in particular also for customs**

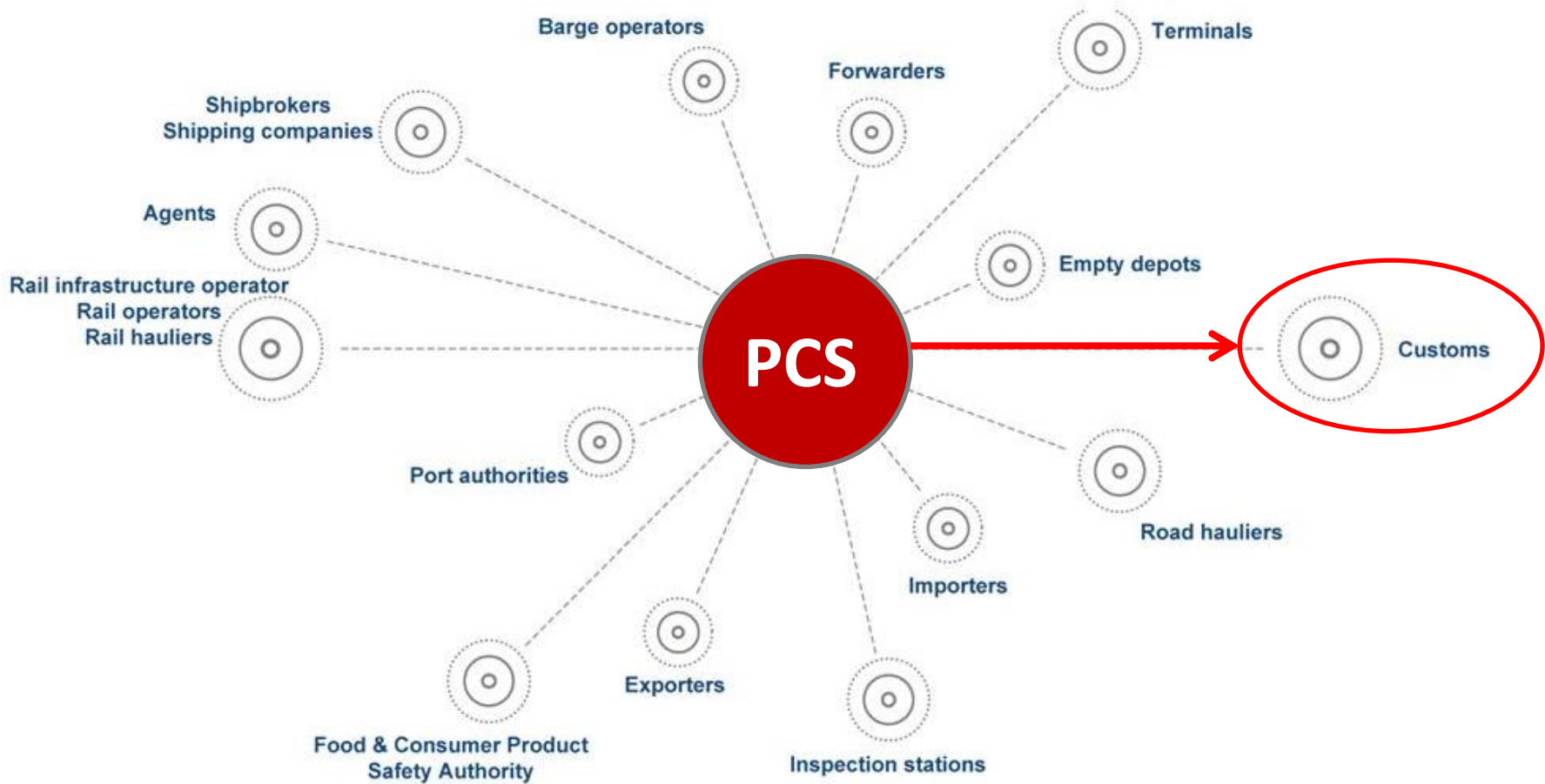
→ PCS = IT Gateway / data collector + data distributor

Single Window

What to do next? → SW



- Extensive analysis
- COM + MS + Trade = create a business case document
- Define clearly the scope
- Tests within the pilot project
- Discussions on EU level (TAXUD) about MASP
