# Logistics and Customs Clearance

**What is the most important goal for the logistics industry?**

- **In-time delivery !**
  - 24 / 7
  - Goods must move!



# Aims for Customs

## Customs ?

- Risk analysis
  - Control measures on goods
  - Customs supervision
  - Collection of import duties
- **Customs is a key player in the supply chain**



# Supply chain

## Customs Clearance →

- Necessary and required !

## But →

- As fast as possible
- Simple
- Low burden (process)
- Compliant
- With reasonable effort

# Single Window

## MSW → activities DG Move

- “New” Extension MSW / e-Manifest pilot = Integration of Customs matters
  - Arrival Notification
  - Notification about Presentation
  - Declaration for Temporary Storage
  - **Not included = ENS**

# Single Window

**What to do next? → SW**



- Extensive analysis
- COM + MS + Trade = create a business case document
- Define clearly the scope
- Tests within the pilot project
- Discussions on EU level (TAXUD) about MASP
- Croatia → ...
