Customs Clearance →


Necessary and required !

Single Window

 $MSW \rightarrow activities DG Move$

- "New" Extension MSW / e-Manifest pilot = Integration of Customs matters
 - Arrival Notification
 - Notification about Presentation
 - Declaration for Temporary Storage
 - Not included = ENS



Single Window

What to do next? \rightarrow SW

- Extensive analysis
- COM + MS + Trade = create a business case document
- Define clearly the scope
- Tests within the pilot project
- Discussions on EU level (TAXUD) about MASP
- Croatia \rightarrow ...
