 - The regional development component (IPA Component III) may support operations under the following priorities:
 - a) Transport infrastructure, in particular interconnection and interoperability between national networks and national and trans-European networks

Transport Operational Programme (TOP):

 - Represents EU and national funds of in excess of 100 million euro
 - Work will continue after accession with enhanced funding under Structural Instruments

Project results:

- Improvement of the efficiency and coordination of particular processes as set out in the Manuals of Procedures
- Direct assistance with the holding of Sectoral Monitoring Committee meetings
- Identification and improvement of the reporting requirements for sectoral and annual reporting by the OS to the SMC
- Assistance with effective programme monitoring
- Eight relevant training courses

Future actions:
