IPA Component IIIA

- IPA IR 718/2007 Article 147:
 - The regional development component (IPA Component III) may support operations under the following priorities:
 - a) Transport infrastructure, in particular interconnection and interoperability between national networks and national and trans-European networks







Operating Structure (OS)

- OS for implementation of IPA IIIA:
 - Body Responsible for Operational Programme (BROP)
 - Ministry of the Sea, Transport and Infrastructure
 - Body Responsible for Priority / Measure (BRPM)
 - Directorate of Strategic Infrastructure Objects
 - Implementing Bodies
 - Croatian Railways Infrastructure (CRI)
 - Central Finance and Contracting Agency







Transport Operational Programme (TOP)

- OS responsible for implementation of the TOP:
 - Implemented over three priority axes:
 - Railway upgrade and improvement
 - Inland waterways
 - Technical assistance
 - Represents EU and national funds of in excess of 100 million euro







Project Objectives

- Overall objective:
 - To prepare Croatia for effective management and absorption of IPA assistance, thereby enhancing Croatia's capacity for effective use of the Structural and Cohesion Funds upon EU accession







Project Objectives

- Specific objective:
 - To enhance capacities of the Operating Structure bodies for project management and management of the Transport Operational Programme







- Project approach:
 - 1. Project will address the objectives through three components:
 - i. Operational Programme level management
 - ii. Priority level management
 - iii. Project level management







- Project approach:
 - 1. Operational Programme level management
 - This component will primarily support MSTI, as the Body Responsible for the OP management, and Head of Operating Structure (HOS) by providing technical assistance during implementation of the entire programme
 - Financial management
 - Programme monitoring
 - Work planning
 - Risk assessment
 - Control reporting







- Project approach:
 - 2. Priority level management
 - This component will support the line ministry, i.e. DSIO in the MSTI as the Body Responsible for Priorities in the field of implementation of projects
 - Project financial management
 - Payment procedures
 - Accounting
 - Risk assessment
 - Managing exceptions







- Project approach:
 - 3. Project level management
 - This component will support Croatian Railways Infrastructure Ltd (CRI) and the Central Finance and Contracting Agency (CFCA) as Implementing Bodies in the technical implementation of projects
 - Control of project implementation
 - Payments and repayments
 - Monitoring of financial and physical progress







Project results:

- Increased capacity of bodies within the IPA Operating Structure for III A component for operational programme level management, priority level management and project level management,
- The Operating Structure trained to fulfil its responsibilities for implementing the Operational Programme,
- All necessary reports, programmes, minutes and other documents required from the Head of the Operating Structure and bodies within prepared in a professional and timely manner,
- The Head of the Operating Structure and all bodies within the Operating Structure adequately prepared for and supported during the regular sectoral monitoring committees
