The MSTI within this project, among other activities, plans to upgrade the National Maritime Single Window, Nautical Information Service application as well as to implement the exchange of Maritime Safety Information Messages through the AIS platform (total budget of the MSTI in the project being € 265.020,00, out of which € 39.753,00 national co-financing).
