- Procurement of two new ro-ro passenger ships, double ended ferries, electric hybrid propulsion, capacity: 80 cars and 500 passengers
- Procurement of one new ro-ro passenger ship, double ended ferry, electric hybrid propulsion, capacity: 170 cars and 1200 passengers
