

TRANSPOGOOD is a project implemented under our leadership.
The main goal of the project was to create an innovative ICT tool TRANSPOGOOD platform which serves to find the best solutions for
transport services. The platform includes a calculator that tracks logistics
and environmental performance.

The project has contributed to improving the quality, safety and environmental sustainability of maritime and coastal transport in the program area by promoting multimodality and the use of sustainable forms of transport.

Total project budget: 1.170.990,00 EUR Project duration: 21 months 01.01.2018.-30.09.2019. The project was implemented by 4 Italian and 4 Croatian partners as part of the Interreg Italy-Croatia cross-border cooperation programme.

CONNECT2CE

Improved rail connections and smart mobility in Central Europe

CONNECT2CE aimed at tackling the weak accessibility of regional, peripheral and cross-border areas of Central Europe by promoting new public transport services to link these areas to the urban areas where the main transport networks and hubs are located.

CONNECT2CE has done so by elaborating harmonized and coordinated strategies and tools which are mainstreamed and implemented at regional and cross-border levels through connected and intertwined pilot actions.

Total project budget: 2.703.435,20 EUR Project duration: 36 months 01.06.2017.-31.05.2020.



The project was implemented by 4 Italian, 2 Hungarian, 2 Slovenian, 1 Czech, 1 German, 1 Austrian and 2 Croatian partners as part of the Interreg Central Europe programme.



REIF

Regional infrastructure for railway freight transport - revitalised



The goal of the REIF project is to improve regional freight transport systems and services with an emphasis on the accessibility of the TEN-T corridor hinterland to national and transnational transport networks in order to contribute to relieving road traffic and switching to greener and safer means of transport.

Total project budget: 2.215.341,50 EUR
Project duration: 36 months 01.04.2019.-31.03.2022.

The project is currently being implemented by 2 German, 3 Italian, 2 Slovenian, 1 Austrian, 1 Polish and 1 Croatian partner as part of the Interreg Central Europe programme.



ICARUS

Intermodal Connections in Adriatic – Ionian Region to Upgrowth Seamless solutions for passenger



The aim of the ICARUS project is to improve intermodal transport links and enable the coast to be connected to the hinterland in order to promote a car-independent lifestyle.

Within the ICARUS project, we have developed an online platform for the promotion of integrated public transport and active forms of movement in the Primorje-Gorski Kotar County.

Each partner within the project conducted a survey on the mobility needs and gaps in their region, as part of which a public survey was conducted on the topic of public transport usage habits.

Total project budget: 2.200.000,00 EUR Project duration: 39 months 01.01.2019.-31.03.2022.

The project is currently being implemented by 7 Italian and 3 Croatian partners as part of the Interreg Italy-Croatia cross-border cooperation programme.

Maritime culture to foster Balanced territorial growth







The overall goal of the REMEMBER project is to promote sustainable tourism and blue growth in the programme area through the valorization of important maritime cultural heritage of 8 Adriatic ports — Ravenna, Ancona, Venice, Trieste, Rijeka, Zadar, Split and Dubrovnik.

Within the project, the ADRIJO cultural network was established, and 8 virtual museums are being created, one for each port.

development of a smart plug-in to support interoperable sectoral systems.

MultiAPPRO & MultiAPPRO PLUS

Multidisciplinary approach and solutions to development of intermodal transport in region - PLUS



MultiAPPRO PLUS is a project implemented under our leadership, it is the continuation of the MultiAPPRO project in 2022.

The goal of the project is to promote freight transport logistics, strive to make intermodal transportation more competitive and put maritime freight transport on equal footing with other transport modes, as well as continue the creation of frameworks that incentivize investments for the modernization of ports in the Adriatic-Ionian region and continue reviewing the progress made in the development of sustainable mobility as previously proposed by the European Commission.

Total project budget: 145.688,40 EUR

Project duration: 6 months 01.01.2022.-30.06.2022.

The project is being implemented by 2 Greek, 2 Italian, 1 Montenegrin, 1 Albanian and 1 Croatian partner as part of the Interreg Adrion programme.

Nodes Enhancing Waterway bridging Adriatic-Ionian Network Plus




NEWBRAIN PLUS is the follow up project of NEWBRAIN aiming at increasing the awareness among the European, National and Macroregional stakeholders in the field of logistics and transport about the importance of the role of Motorways of the Sea in the Adriatic-Ionian region and their connection to land transport infrastructures for the freight transport flows between the two shores of the Adriatic-Ionian Sea.

NEWBRAIN PLUS will promote and enhance the NEWBRAIN transnational strategy which identified a list of common areas of interest for the strengthening of transnational institutional cooperation during the next programming period (2021-2027)

Total project budget: 149.365,01 EUR Project duration: 6 months 01.01.2022.-30.06.2022.
