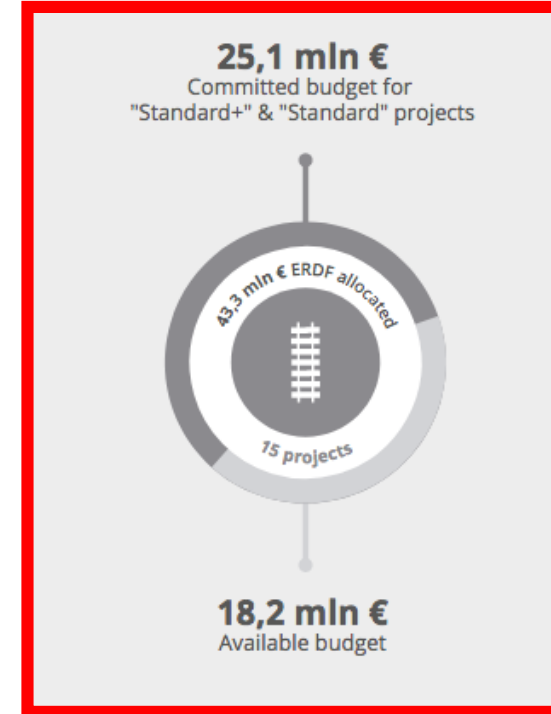

GUTTA's main objective is to support the decarbonisation of the existing CB maritime links through optimized operations

- ② To facilitate the implementation of the MRV, providing feedbacks and analyses
- ③ To facilitate the establishment of at least one new CB maritime link, after COVID-19 pandemic

GUTTA's main output is GUTTA-VISIR, a pilot-system for planning ferry routes that minimize ferry CO₂ emissions, based on the knowledge of the forecast meteo-marine conditions
