NOTE VERBALE

The Ministry for Innovation and Technology of Hungary presents its compliments to the Embassy of the Republic of Croatia in Budapest and has the honour to inform of the following:

According to the decision of the Government of Hungary dated 10 March 2022 transport restriction will be applied in Hungary from 11 to 15 March 2022 because of the national holiday. Traffic restrictions for heavy goods vehicles over 7,5 t will be in place from 22:00 on Friday, 11 March until 22:00 on Tuesday, 15 March. The truck stop will be suspended for a period of ten-ten hours, from 22:00 to 8:00 on Sunday and on Monday to ensure a smooth supply of goods. Vehicles transporting daily consumer goods during this period are also exempted from the restriction. According to the general rules, vehicles transporting, among others, live animals, perishable foodstuffs or fuel are exempted from the restriction.

According to Government Decree 190/2008 (VII. 29.) humanitarian consignments are exempt from transport restrictions by default in Hungary; however, a short declaration in Hungarian must be completed. The template for the declaration is attached to the current Note Verbale.

The Ministry for Innovation and Technology of Hungary avails itself of this opportunity to renew to the Embassy of the Republic of Croatia in Budapest the assurances of its highest consideration.
